Program Details:

Teaching Requirements:

Minimum visit duration - 5 working days and more, up to a maximum of 2 months (depending on budget).

All mobility periods include 2 days travel, e.g. 5 working days + 2 travel days = 7 days.

Participants are required to deliver a minimum of 8 hours teaching per week (or part of week).

Teaching can take on a variety of different forms, such as guest presentations in local courses related to expertise, workshops for graduate/doctoral student, one on one supervision, public lectures, etc.

Support for research-based stays is not provided within the scope of Erasmus+, however, research activities may be conducted in combination with a teaching stay.

Funding:

Travel and Daily Subsistence will be provided, as per the EU rates (see table above), as per number of teaching days (minimum 5) and 2 days travel.

Coverage of travel costs and charges are the responsibility of the host institution.

The host University will provide information regarding the reimbursement procedure (which vary from institution to institution).

Booking flights and accommodation are the responsibility of the faculty member (usually with the assistance of the host institution).
