APPLYING TO PARTICIPATE IN THE STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM

Students who wish to participate in the student exchange program must submit their application to the International Office in accordance with the instructions below.

After an internal selection process, the Hebrew University will submit the selected students as candidates to the host universities, who then undergo their own selection procedures. Confirmation of final acceptance to the student exchange program will be given by the host institution.

A. ELIGIBILITY FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

- A bachelor's degree student in the second or third year of study towards the bachelor's degree - provided that the student has a minimum of 10 credit units remaining in the 2021/2022 academic year.
- A third-year student bachelor's degree student who plans to begin master's degree studies in the 2021/2022 academic year - subject to approval by the relevant department, in advance.
- A master's degree student in the 2021/2022 academic year - subject to approval by the relevant department, in advance.



- Doctoral candidates at various stages.
- The student must have a general GPA of 80 or above.

B . ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS FOR CANDIDATES WHO PASSED THE INTRA-UNIVERSITY EVALUATION PROCESS

- Students who apply for student exchange program at institutions where the language of instruction is English may be required to meet a threshold score on the TOEFL / IELTS exam. Please check carefully what each institution's language requirements are (listed in the table).
- At institutions at which the language of instruction is not English, knowledge of the local language of instruction is a prerequisite for acceptance into the program. Contact the [Language Studies Unit](#) in the Faculty of Humanities and sign the Certification of Language Proficiency form as required (see the form attached below).
- Students accepted for study in the student exchange program **must receive academic approval for the courses that they intend to study abroad from the Instructional Matters Office/ the International Coordinator in the mother faculty unit prior to departure for student exchange study.**

- Bachelor's degree students are obligated to study a minimum of 10 credit units and up to a maximum of 20 credit units (in the theoretical sciences) or 25 credit units (in the experimental sciences) at the host institution. The student will receive recognition for these units on their transcript as "study abroad."
- Master's degree students are required to study up to a maximum of 10 credit units, subject to confirmation from the student's advisor/counselor of the contribution that participation in the student exchange will make to the student's education/ research.
- Studies carried out during the academic exchange will not be considered degree studies at the host university.

C . COSTS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

- A student who is accepted to participate in the student exchange program will be registered in advance at the Hebrew University and will be charged tuition in accordance with the rules .
- All participants in the exchange program are exempt from the host institution tuition.
- Students will receive a one-time grant from the International Office and/or scholarships granted by certain institutions as specified in the table above.



D. GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF CANDIDACY

Before applying:

- Please read carefully all of the information provided in the various university information pages (via the links in the table above).
- Please evaluate carefully all of the considerations involved in deciding to study abroad (including study/ family/ employment/ costs/ health, etc.).
- You may select up to three institutions at which you are interested in travelling to study abroad (in descending order of priority). These three choices can include both institutions from the bilateral track as well as institutions in the Erasmus+ track.
- Students who wish to select the University of California as one of their choices should see the instructions below.

- **On the online form please fill in all of the required information:**
 - Personal details;
 - Choice of up to three educational institutions;
 - The preliminary choice of courses at each selected institution.
- **Please attach the following documents to your application :**
 - Curriculum Vitae (CV, in English).
 - Academic Transcripts **in Hebrew and English :**
- **In Hebrew** (printout from the personal information available online, with a general grade average for all years of study at the University, for all degrees);
- And **in English** (obtain your official transcript from the faculty office).
 - A separate Letter of Motivation for each institution that you selected (in English). In your letter, describe the reasons that you selected the institution/s at which you are interested to study, while addressing the

relationship between the curriculum offered at the foreign institution and your current and/or future academic studies, and the courses that you specified in the application form, language study/multiculturalism etc.

- At institutions at which English is not the language of instruction, knowledge of the local language is a prerequisite to admission to the program. You must contact the Language Studies Unit in the Humanities Faculty and sign a form certifying knowledge of the required language (the form is attached below), in accordance with the language required at the institution in question.
- **For master's degree and doctoral students only** - You must attach a letter of recommendation (in English) from a university lecturer addressed "To Whom It May Concern." The letter should be transmitted directly to the International Office in accordance with the instructions on the application website.

- **Special instructions for students applying for the University of California (UC)**

The UC is a network of nine institutions in California, USA. Each campus has a different and unique character.

On the online application form, you should mark the University of California (one option) as one institution out of the three institutions to which you wish to study as part of the student exchange program. On the course detail screen pertaining to UC, please mark 15 courses- 5 courses for each UC campus requested.

Please note that the UC Berkeley and UCLA campuses are very popular, and competition for places at these campuses is difficult. In addition, the final placement to a campus is carried out by UC, and there is no guarantee that the student will be admitted to study at the campus that they ranked as their first choice.

Prepare one letter of motivation for the UC relating to all three campuses at which you wish to study.

E. EVALUATION

After the closing of the application period, all complete applications will be forwarded to the faculty/university committee for evaluation and decisions.

Compliance with the conditions specified for applying does not mean automatic acceptance in the exchange programs. As mentioned above, the final approval for participation in the student exchange program will be granted by the host institution.

F . ACCEPTANCE

The results of the evaluation process will be conveyed to the candidates at the conclusion of the evaluation process, at the end of January.

Successful candidate must transmit to the International office confirmation of their participation in the student exchange program within 7 days of receiving the assignment.

**Failure to approve participation in the exchange program will be considered a waiver of the assignment, and the place will be transferred to the second round of assignment of candidates.
