SCHOLARSHIP FOR STUDENT EXCHANGE: THE ERASMUS+ PROGRAM AT EUROPEAN INSTITUTIONS

FOR THE 2021-2022 ACADEMIC YEAR

As part of the student exchange programs offered by the Hebrew University, the Erasmus+ program offers bachelor's, master's and doctoral degree students scholarships for <u>one semester</u> of study at leading academic institutions in Europe.

The table below lists the institutions that are part of the student exchange program, and their requirements and conditions for study abroad.

APPLYING TO PARTICIPATE IN THE STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM

Students who wish to participate in the student exchange program must submit their application to the International Office in accordance with the instructions below.

After an internal selection process, Hebrew University will submit the selected students as candidates to the host universities, who then undergo their own selection procedures. Confirmation of final acceptance to the student exchange program will be given by the host institution.



A. ELIGIBILTY FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

- To be eligible to apply, the student must be one of the following:
- A bachelor's degree student in the second or third year of study towards the bachelor's degree provided that the student has a minimum of 10 credit units remaining in the 2021/2022 academic year.
- A third-year student bachelor's degree student who plans to begin master's degree studies in the 2021/2022 academic year subject to approval by the relevant department, in advance.
- A master's degree student in the 2021/2022 academic year subject to approval by the relevant department, in advance.
- Doctoral candidates at various stages.
- The student must have a general GPA of 80 or above.



B. ACADEMIC REQUIREMENT FOR STUDENTS WHO PASSED THE INTRA-UNIVERSITY EVALUATION PROCESS

- Students who apply for student exchange program at institutions where the language of instruction is English may be required to meet a threshold score on the TOEFL / IELTS exam. Please check carefully what each institution's language requirements are (listed in the table).
- At institutions at which the language of instruction is not English, knowledge of the local language of
 instruction is a prerequisite for acceptance into the program. Contact the <u>Language Studies Unit</u> in
 the Faculty of Humanities and sign the Certification of Language Proficiency form as required (see
 the form attached below).
- Students accepted for study in the student exchange program must receive academic approval for the courses that they intend to study abroad from the Instructional Matters Office/ the International Coordinator in the mother faculty unit prior to departure for student exchange study.
- Bachelor's degree students are obligated to study a <u>minimum</u> of 10 credit units and up to a <u>maximum</u> of 20 credit units (in the theoretical sciences) or 25 credit units (in the experimental sciences) at the



host educational institution. The student will receive recognition for these units on their transcript as "study abroad."

- Master's degree students are required to study up to a <u>maximum of</u> 10 credit units, subject to confirmation from the student's advisor/counselor of the contribution that participation in the student exchange will make to the student's education/ research.
- Studies carried out during the academic exchange will not be considered degree studies at the host university.

C. COSTS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

- A student who is accepted to participate in the student exchange program will be registered <u>in</u> advance at the Hebrew University and will be charged tuition <u>in accordance with the rules</u>.
- All participants in the exchange program are exempt from the host institution tuition.
- Students will receive a one-time grant from the International Office and/or scholarships granted by certain institutions as specified in the table above.



D. GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF CANDIDACY

Before applying:

- Please read carefully all of the information provided in the various university information pages (via the links in the table above).
- Please evaluate carefully all of the considerations (including study/ family/ employment/ costs/ health, etc.) involved in deciding to study abroad.
- You may select up to three institutions at which you are interested in travelling to study abroad (in descending order of priority). These three choices can include both institutions from the bilateral route as well institutions in the Erasmus+ track.

- On the online form please fill in all of the required information:
- Personal details;
- Choice of up to three <u>educational</u> institutions;
- And the preliminary choice of courses at each selected institution.
- Please attach the following documents to your application:
 - Curriculum Vitae (in English).
 - Academic Transcripts in Hebrew and English :
- **In Hebrew** (From the personal information available online, with a general grade average for all years of study at the University, for all degrees);
- And **in English** (official transcript from the faculty office).
 - A <u>separate</u> Letter of Motivation for each institution requested (in English). In your letter, describe the reasons that you selected the institution/s at which you are interested to study, while commenting on the relationship between the curriculum offered at the foreign institution and your current and/or future academic studies, and the courses that you specified in the application form, language study/multiculturalism etc.



- At institutions at which English is not the language of instruction, knowledge of the local language is a perquisite to admission to the program. You must contact the Language Studies Unit in the Humanities Faculty and sign a form certifying knowledge of the required language (the form is attached below), in accordance with the language required at the institution in question.
- For master's degree and doctoral students only You must attach a letter of recommendation (in English) from a university lecturer addressed "To Whom It May Concern." The letter should be transmitted directly to the International Office in accordance with the instructions on the application website.

E. EVALUATION

After the closing of the application period, all complete applications will be forwarded to the faculty/university committee for evaluation and decisions.

Compliance with the conditions specified for applying <u>does not mean automatic acceptance</u> in the exchange programs. As mentioned above, the final approval for participation in the student exchange program will be granted by the host institution.



F. ACCEPTANCE

The results of the evaluation process will be conveyed to the candidates at the conclusion of the evaluation process, at the end of January.

Successful candidate must transmit to the International office confirmation of their participation in the student exchange program within 7 days of receiving the assignment.

**Failure to approve participation in the exchange program will be considered a waiver of the assignment, and the place will be transferred to the second round of assignment of candidates.
