<p><b>German Language Courses for Erasmus students</b></p> <p><b>Application</b></p>	<p>Students staying for a whole semester may take part in a German language course.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ 4 hrs per week</li> <li>▪ equals 3 ECTS-credits that can be included in the transcript of records upon agreement with the Erasmus departmental coordinator</li> <li>▪ free of charge</li> </ul> <p>Student who wish to participate in a German language course need <b>to state this in their online-application</b>. Further information on placement test and the course will be send to students by mail.</p>

Formalities	
<p><b>Visa</b></p> <p><b>Passport</b></p>	<p>Students with Israeli nationality do not require a visa to enter Germany.</p> <p><i>They however need to apply for a residence permit to the Immigration Office in Germany after their arrival when staying longer than 3 months in Germany. The International Office will support them in doing this.</i></p> <p>Students need a passport valid for the whole period of their stay and preferably 6 months beyond.</p>

<p><b>Insurance</b></p> <p>Health insurance</p> <p>Liability insurance</p> <p>Accident insurance</p>	<p><b>i</b> <b>The Erasmus program does not include any insurance.</b></p> <p><b>Students need to provide proof of a sufficient health insurance which covers the whole study abroad period for their enrolment at the University of Bonn.</b></p> <p>a) This might be a private international health insurance. <b>Please note:</b> Health insurance policies will not be accepted if the coverage is not equivalent to the coverage of a German compulsory health insurance! This must cover urgent cases of sickness and accidents, psychological treatment and, if applicable, chronic diseases, pregnancy and delivery. The coverage of repatriation costs is highly recommended.</p> <p>b) Students might also get a German health insurance upon arrival (cost. 103 € per month). In this case they should make sure to have a basic travel health insurance for the first few days in Germany.
